

**32nd Sunday After Pentecost (Tone 7)**  
**St Euthymius the Great**  
**1 Timothy 4: 9 – 15      Luke 19: 1 - 10**

**Beatitude Verses**  
8 from Octoechos for Resurrection

**People:** In Your kingdom remember us, O Lord, when You come into Your kingdom.  
Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.  
Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted!  
Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth!  
Blessed are those who hunger and thirst after righteousness, for they shall be filled!  
Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy!

**Reader:** The fruit which slew me was beautiful and good to eat; but Christ is the Tree of Life, and eating of Him I do not die, but cry out with the Robber: Remember me, O Lord, in Your kingdom!

**People:** Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God!

**Reader:** O Compassionate Lord, who was lifted up on the Cross, You have erased the record of Adam's ancient sin, and have saved the whole human race from deception. Therefore, we praise You, O Lord and Benefactor.

**People:** Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God!

**Reader:** O compassionate Christ, You nailed our sins to the Cross, and by Your death You slew death, O You who raised up the dead from among the dead. Therefore, we venerate Your holy resurrection.

**People:** Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven!

**Reader:** The serpent once poured its venom into the ears of Eve; but on the tree of the Cross, Christ poured forth the sweetness of life upon the world. Therefore, we cry out: Remember us, O Lord, in Your kingdom!

**People:** Blessed are you when people revile you, persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for my sake!

**Reader:** O Christ the Life of all, You were laid in the tomb as one dead; and You broke down the gates of Hades; and having risen again in glory on the third day as One mighty, You have illumined all. Glory to Your arising!

**People:** Rejoice, and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven!

**Reader:** Having risen from the dead on the third day, the Lord bestowed His peace upon His disciples; and having blessed them, He sent them forth saying: Lead all into My kingdom!

**People:** **Glory** to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

**Reader:** The Father is light; the Son and Word is light; and the Holy Spirit is light. Yet the Three are one Light, for they are one God in three Persons, One in nature and origin, indivisible, unconfused and pre-eternal.

**People:** **Now** and ever, and to the ages of ages. Amen.

**Reader:** O Theotokos, for our sake you gave birth in the flesh to the Son and Word of the Father, just as you declared. Therefore, O Virgin Mother, we who are deified through you cry out: Rejoice, hope of Christians!
